#### Destination Aviation Day Camp Ages 11-18

Destination Aviation Day Camp for ages 11-18 is an age appropriate, flight based curriculum that varies from year to year. As campers mature, their tasks become more complex and challenging. Campers learn about the parts of an airplane, aerodynamics, basic navigation, weather, prepping and flying aircraft.
