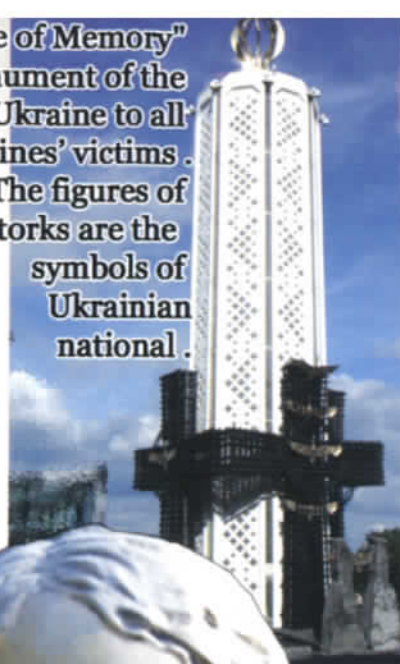
During XX century Ukrainian nation had experienced wars, collectivisation, Holodomors 1921-1922 and 1932-1933, "Great terror" 1936-1939, Nazi occupation and had endured the famine of 1946-1947 and numerous repressions after the World War II.

The Memorial in commemoration of famines` victims in Ukraine was founded to immortalize the memory of innocent victims.

The complex was built on the Pechersk Hills, in one of the picturesque and ancient places of the Kyiv. It is on the high bank of the Dnieper River, near Lavra Caves.

The main parts of the Memorial: the Candle of Memory, The Hall of Memory and the Alley "The blackboards of Ukraine".

"The Candle of Memory" is the monument of the revived Ukraine to all the famines` victims. The figures of storks are the symbols of Ukrainian national.

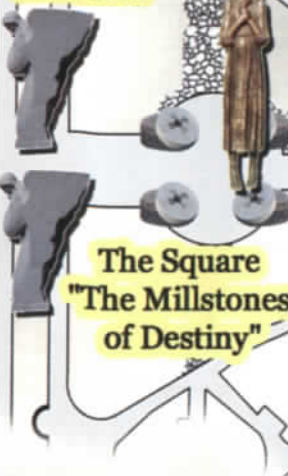

There is the sculpture "Sad memory of childhood" in the centre of the Square "The Millstones of Destiny". The exhausted starving girl holds 5 ears in her small hands. It is the symbol of the so-called "Law of five ears".



The Alley "The Tillage of Memory" leads to the Square "The Millstones of Destiny".

At the entrance of the Memorial there are the sculptures "The Angels of Sorrow" – the symbolical guardians of the souls of famines` victims.
