The Mighty Mo is a Pearl Harbor Must See!

The USS *Missouri* was launched on January 29, 1944, and is the last U.S. battleship ever built. After joining the battle for Okinawa, she became the site of the Japanese surrender on September 2, 1945. Today, she stands proudly overlooking her fallen sister ship, the USS *Arizona*, providing closure for America's fight to bring peace to the Pacific.

MIGHTY MO PASS

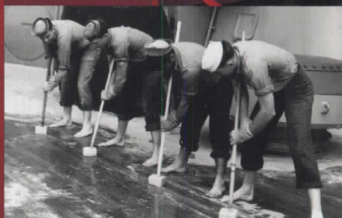

THE HEART OF THE MISSOURI TOUR

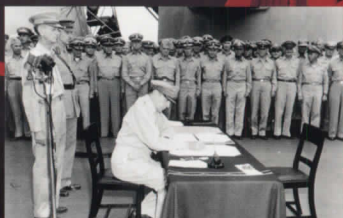
(75 min, additional fee. Limited to ages 10 and above.)

What does it take to move a ship three football fields long at a speed of nearly 40 MPH? How can one 16 inch gun fire a 2,700 pound projectile to an incredible 23 miles with pinpoint accuracy? The Heart of the Missouri Tour showcases the power and the mechanics behind the Mighty Mo, one of the greatest battleships of all time, which was designed for speed and firepower.

For your safety, please note this is a very strenuous tour and closed-toe shoes are required. This intimate tour has a capacity of ten visitors at one time.



You'll get a taste of shipboard living as you view the way our men lived. With some areas still preserved in their active-service state, the battleship provides an accurate account of how these brave men spent countless days and months at sea.
